



# **Part IV: Apply to Barrett, The Honors College**



**Barrett, The Honors College at ASU**

- 1. The Barrett application and essay topic are available at: [barretthonors.asu.edu/admissions/high-school-students](https://barretthonors.asu.edu/admissions/high-school-students)**
- 2. Send in your SAT and/or ACT scores.**
- 3. Prospective students will use the Barrett application to identify and then send notification emails to two recommenders. These messages will contain directions for how to electronically submit the letters, which should be Microsoft Word or PDF documents.**



A complete Barrett application is defined as:

1. The student has finished all sections of the application, including the required essay.
2. The Barrett application has been submitted, not just saved.
3. All letters of recommendation identified on the application have been received.
4. The student has been admitted to an Arizona State University undergraduate degree program with a test score, ACT or SAT, on file with Undergraduate Admissions.\*

\* Though a Barrett application may be started and submitted before ASU admission is conferred, it cannot go to evaluation until university acceptance is formally awarded.
